2009 Spring Fly Casting Classes

Guy and Woody, both FFF Master Certified Casting Instructors, will be holding their annual Spring Beginners Fly Casting Classes beginning in April. These classes run on 5 Tuesdays (or Mondays if you can't make Tuesday) for 2 hours each class. Classes begin at 6 PM and run until about 8 PM each evening. They will be held on the lawn across between the Redding Convention Center and Channel 7 in the Turtle Bay Area.

The classes will cost \$50 per person for the whole series of 5 classes. Bring a rod, with a matching reel and line. Add a 7 foot leader in 3 or 4 X size and we will supply the fluff. Reservations are not needed so just show up. Please show up at least 5 minutes early for each class to allow time to set up your gear. All classes will begin promptly at 6 PM.
