# **Fishout Reports**

#### 2010 Delta Striper - Fishout

The month of November is a great time to fish the Sacramento/ San Joaquin Delta. The weather is outstanding and generally at this time of year a great number of striped bass are lurking in its depths. Someone forgot to tell the striped bass this year and fishing was tough for the 10 – 20 pounders.

STFF members **Allan Craig, John Gantner, Dale Huffman, Don Wieseman, John Thorn, Art Agnew,** and **Dave Allred** along with his brother ventured to this estuary the first week of November in hopes of luring the elusive striper to their fly. Most of the time was spent casting flies around the legendary hot spots of Franks Track, False River, and the San Joaquin River with only an occasional 18-inch plus fish being caught. Allan Craig and John Gantner fished together with Allan being the hot rod in the boat. Allan landed a number of fish ranging from just legal to an occasional 4 – 5 pounder. Don Wieseman and John Thorn did well catching a few "legal" sized fish. Dave and his brother were also getting a few legal fish and in the Agnew/Huffman boat; Dale prevailed as the master fisher getting a few really nice legal stripers.

## Manzanita Lake – Fishout

Ten hearty club members bundled up and attended. Temperature outside 42 degrees; water temperature 45 degrees; we all got in the lake to warm up. Gerald Nelson brought coffee and sweet rolls. Once the sun was up it warmed the air nicely.

Attendees were **Tony and Linda Holdren, Jim Murphy, Ralph Lestarjette, Norm Brown, Jeff Collins, Art Agnew, Ric Raffanti and Gerald Nelson** along with myself. What a beautiful day as it turned out.

A variety of leaders and lines were used with several different flies. Jeff Collins and Jim Murphy landed eleven fish including 5 brown trout to 19 inches. Jim was high rod for the day with 5 fish landed.

There were a large number of insects and birds out in the early afternoon. Most fish were caught on intermediate lines and a few floating lines. Jim Murphy reported using a Richards Stillwater nymph on an intermediate line and Jeff Collins used an orange and green Jay Fair wiggle tail. Along with a crimson wiggle tail he purchased from The Fly Shop. By wiggle tail, he meant marabou. Norm Brown had success with a Twist Nymph on a dropper and floating line. Carl Jaegger taught us this nymph at a Saturday Fly Tying session at the "Good Times Pizza Parlor" earlier this year.
