We ended the day at the One Maple Vineyards where our host Ernie poured some nice chardonnays and cabernets. It was a fitting ending to a fine day on the Trinity River with all attendees reporting an abundance of sharing and camaraderie.

The water level continued to drop throughout the day and the clarity improved; however, no one seemed to inform the steelhead.
