Fishing Locations: Depending on fish; locations Lewiston to Del Loma

Equipment: 6 wt to 8 wt. Line of your choice. (Speydicator or Floating wt forward) Tippet 2x or 3X, 4X only in very low clear water. Switch and Spey rods are a good choice.

Methods: Cold water (45°F or colder) Nymph fishing under an indicator. Warmer water: 45° to 65°F, swinging, surface or indicator. Flies of your choice and method of fishing. Salmon on spawn use nymph and at least glow bug or bead as one of the flies. Weight to match flow being fished. Start with 6' leader if nymphing.

Traditionalist: Use size 8 to 2/0 flies and swing with long leader 3x tippet min 9 to 12'. Dark flies etc., e.g., Egg Sucking Leech, Gray and Copper, Burlaps, Silver Hilton, Green Butt Skunk, etc. Sink tips if you want with weighted flies.

Dries: Always possible to fish dries in afternoon. Skate Muddlers or other top water. BWO 12 - 16.

Flies: #8 - 12 Golden Stone, #10 14 Poxy Hare's Ear, #10 - 12 Eggs, #12 - 14 Copper Johns, #12 - 14 Flashback PTs. (Your choice)

Notes: Long Line Nymphing, Short Line Nymphing and Downstream Nymphing will work. It is your choice of method. Indicator fishing is big on the Trinity, but can be hard to cast for the beginner.

Bring: Warm Clothing, extra set in case of falling in. Lunch, Beverage, chair, wading staff, felt or wader boots with cleats, sun glasses. The lower part of the river below Weaverville is usually foggy and cold.



Procedure for Selection of Fly Fisher of the Year

- Annually, preceding the annual banquet, the president of STFF will ask the general membership and each of the previous recipients to submit nominations [based upon the criteria listed below] for the award for the current year. In addition, the president may also submit multiple nominations.
- All nominations must be completed using the STFF nomination form which requires a written explanation of the reason the members is being nominated. All nominations should be made in consideration of the criteria that have been established for this award.
- All members whose names are nominated will be submitted to the nomination committee for consideration. The nomination committee will be comprised of all the previous recipients of the Fly Fisher of the Year award plus the president of STFF.
- The nomination committee will submit all the members that are nominated to a vote. The member who receives a highest number of votes will be designated Fly Fisher of the Year.
- A chairperson of the nominating committee will be appointed by the President and will be responsible for obtaining all nominations and administering the voting process by the committee members. Once the voting is completed, the chairperson will report the final result to the President...otherwise the results will not be disclosed until announced at the annual banquet.

Note: In the event of a tie in the final voting, the members receiving the equal number of votes will be submitted to the Board of Directors for a vote. Each Director will have the opportunity to cast only one vote. The name receiving the highest total number of votes will be designated a Fly Fisher of the Year.
