Required Equipment: Bring a fly rod with matching <u>floating</u> line on a reel. Purchase a 9 or 10 foot, 3X tapered leader (available at any fly shop). The leader must be tapered. No strike indicators on level tippet material.

The lessons will include overhead casting, how to make well-formed loops, roll casting, shooting line and shortening line, how to adjust your cast for the amount of line extended and simple mending.

Because the classes follow a step by step progression, missing any but the last class will put you at least two lessons behind the others. The instructor cannot take time out away from the other students to catch you up, as there is insufficient time to do so, and you will likely not be up to the skill level to proceed on the following lessons. So it is strongly suggested that you attend all classes. If you cannot make it to all of the classes, it is suggested you not attend.

At the conclusion of the five weeks, if there is sufficient interest and commitment, there will be free follow-up casting sessions, open to all, through the summer on alternate Tuesday evenings. No need to sign up. Just show up.
